TALK OF THE TOWN: Quail Creek Women give big time

The Women of Quail Creek want to thank the community for help in making "A Taste of Quail Creek Cookbook" project so successful.

A total of 2,305 cookbooks were sold by the organization. All of the profits from the sale benefited the local Green Valley-Sahuarita Community Food Bank. Approximately \$10,504 was presented to the food bank, enabling the organization to purchase approximately \$110,288 of food to assist those in need.
