It's that simple.

The Women of Quail Creek's website and Friday Morning Messages (homepage) are setup for computer/laptop view (larger than a smartphone or iPad screen in most cases), therefore making that the best place to see everything “intact”. Basic (text) content is readable viewing from any device, and the skewed “view” will not create any restrictions associated with links on the page you are viewing.
